

Junior Golf Clinics Beginners intermediate & advanced tuition

The Vintage Junior Golf Foundation through Richard Mercer, Head Teaching Professional at The Vintage Golf Club, presents the **Pathway to Junior Golf Program.** This program is unique to The Vintage Junior Golf Foundation in that it provides children with a structured pathway into the sport of golf at the beginner level, providing advancement to a full AGU handicap for all levels of golfer and onto Elite level amateur golf for those with high skill levels.

The initial programs for beginner golfers through to a full AGU handicap standard are divided into three levels: Beginner, Intermediate and Advanced. The Beginner course is designed to teach children the basic skills of the golf swing from the basic set up and the various types of shots required in the golf skill set. The Intermediate course is designed to improve the skills taught in the Beginner course and introduce the rules and etiquette surrounding the game. The Advanced course looks to further improve skills and knowledge of the rules to a point that students are equipped to play competition golf.

Children completing the Beginner (basic skills) course will be in a position to determine whether they wish to further pursue the sport of golf further, with the Intermediate and Advanced courses taking students onto the path of being able to participate in golfing competitions.

All equipment required will be provided by The Vintage Junior Foundation with any children owning their own golf equipment being very welcome to bring that equipment to the courses.

Six week courses are scheduled on Wednesday afternoons in each of the four school terms. New students can join the clinics during any term and stay as part of the program for as long as is necessary.

The cost for Beginners is \$150 per annum with Intermediate and Advanced being \$250 per annum. These fees include a Vintage Junior Golf Foundation shirt and cap and attendance at four consecutive courses. Intermediate and Advanced fees include a Membership of The Vintage.

The course for the current term commences on Wednesday 26 October 2016 and finishes on Wednesday 30 November 2016.

Intermediate and Advanced students will receive a structured lesson from 4.00pm for 30 minutes followed by the playing of a number of holes of golf where they test the skills they have learned. Beginner students will receive structured tuition from 4.30pm for 60 minutes followed by competitions held on the practice fairway or on the putting green where they test the skills they are learning.
